






Arabian horses are considered to be among the oldest horse breeds in the world, if not the oldest ever, since they date back to more than 3,000 years BC, And filled the horizons with its fragrant reputation and dwelled in the minds and hearts of its lovers and educators and knights across the world and among different cultures, a symbol of strength and heritage and authenticity. The Levant, in general, and Syria in particular, had an advanced position in preserving it, and it started to expand to many countries around the world.

The Ministry of Agriculture and Agrarian Reform in the field of registration, documentation and issuance of the books of the original Arabian horse breeds and the combination of a group of lovers of the civilization of this country and in line with the culture and history of the original Equestrian and the glorious past and under the slogan of (the hand of God is with the community) The first founding meeting of the Syrian Arabian Horses Association was held in Damascus on 26/12/2002 and was announced by the Ministry of Social Affairs and Labor No. 1105 dated 26/7/2003. The announcement ceremony was held on 11/10/2003.

The objectives of the Association are as follows:

- Shedding light to the original Arabian horses and all related activities.
- Participation in all local and international conferences related to pure Arabian horses.
- Introducing the Syrian instructors internationally and providing services to them.
- Contribute to improve the offspring of the original Arabian horse and exchange local, Arab and international expertise.
- Preserve the original Arabian horses registered and work to keep them pure and conduct studies, research and experiments to raise the aesthetic and performance of the original horses.
- Dissemination of information on horse breeding and care, writing and translating, training courses for breeders and those interested in authentic Arabian horses, awarding certificates and prizes, and accreditation of certificates issued by others.
- To strengthen relations between horse breeders in Syria and provide services to them and to strengthen their relations with Arab and international organizations and those interested in the Arabian horse and its activities.
- Suggest regulations and instructions governing the breeding of Arabian horses in accordance with the best international standards.

- Organizing local activities (festivals, races, auctions) and following up Arab and international activities.
- Coordination and cooperation with all parties interested in the Arabian horse locally, Arab and internationally.
- Establishment of a library and museum specialized in Arabian horses and the Arabian equestrian.
- Reviving the Arab folklore heritage.
- To raise the original Arabian horses in Syria locally, Arab and internationally.
- Establishment and ownership of projects related to the original Arabian horses (Stables Race Tracks - Equestrian schools).
- Ownership and breeding of pure Arabian horses and contribute to the marketing of the horses of the association and instructors.
- Scientific interest in the historical and documentary aspect of the Syrian Badia and Arab tribes.
- Attention to the Syrian Badia animals such as camels, Saluki and hunting birds.
- Working with government and official agencies in the country to obtain the exemptions and benefits required to serve the original Arabian horses and their activities.
- Cooperating with all organizations, bodies, associations and centers that serve the objectives of the Association.

The achievements of the association since its establishment till now:

- Under the patronage of the President of the Republic, Dr. Bashar Hafez Al-Assad, the WAHO Conference was held in Damascus in 2007 in cooperation with the Ministry of Agriculture and Agrarian Reform, the Arabian Horses Office and the active participation of members of the Board of Directors, the Association, the economic activities and the Arabian Horse Association Authentic in Syria.
- Participation in the European organization for organizing the Arabian Horse Beauty Show (ECAHO) and the International Federation of Arabian Horse Racing (IFAHR).








En effet, 5 ans plus tôt, alors que je rencontrais des occidentaux expatriés dans le monde arabe, je fus stupéfié par leurs méconnaissances et leurs préjugés sur la culture arabe. Je décidais alors dans ce voyage de porter ma culture dans ce monde occidental qui me fascinait.

Depuis je n'ai jamais cessé à travers écrits, films et prises de parole de tisser des liens et construire des ponts entre les civilisations.

Au moment où tant de fanatismes s'acharnent à creuser un fossé infranchissable, d'installer l'incompréhension, voire la haine dans le monde, ce combat culturel reste particulièrement d'actualité.

La guerre que traverse la Syrie laisse un pays blessé et mutilé et son image dans le monde reste celle d'un pays meurtri mais toujours debout. Ces 8 années de guerre ont révélé au monde entier la résistance héroïque du peuple syrien, la vaillance de l'armée arabe syrienne et le courage de son président Bachar Al Assad. Maintenant que la guerre s'achève et que la victoire se dessine, il est nécessaire d'entreprendre des initiatives qui rassemblent les hommes et qui rappelle la véritable histoire du peuple syrien;

Le cheval pur-sang arabe, symbole de notre culture et éternel ambassadeur, de nouveau va permettre de retisser des liens entre les hommes de bonne volonté qui recherchent la paix.

C'est pour cela que j'estime de mon devoir en tant qu'intellectuel et patriote syrien d'aller vers ces peuples avec le symbole le plus fort du cheval pur-sang arabe, pour raviver les liens culturels qui nous unissent et rencontrer les familles liées directement à cette tragédie, des familles amputées, orphelines dont le sang a été mélangé au notre sur ma terre syrienne. Tant d'histoires, tant d'épopées vont remplir les 5 000 km qui séparent Damas de Moscou.

Durant 6 mois des passionnés du monde entier vont suivre ce voyage et ces riches rencontres, aventures, rêves, fraternité, et susciteront la parution d'articles et de livres ainsi que des films ou des documentaires et enfin ouvrir le champ à d'autres expériences similaires entre les jeunes de ces pays. Cette chevauchée fantastique, comme dans les temps anciens, sera néanmoins suivie quotidiennement par les réseaux sociaux avec des milliers de fans, qui de Damas à Moscou, suivront l'aventure sur internet.

Cette aventure d'un autre temps, faite à cheval, sera l'occasion de montrer au monde entier les liens d'amitié qui unissent la Sainte Russie avec ma Sainte terre natale qui a vu naître tous les signes du Ciel.

Je serai fier et heureux d'avoir votre chaîne RT comme compagnon de route, et comme partenaire exclusif afin que l'on puisse ensemble offrir à des millions de téléspectateurs des images de rencontres et d'amitié qui marquent les esprits.

Le 17 avril 2019 jour de la fête nationale syrienne, des centaines de cavaliers venus de toute la Syrie seront dans les rues de Damas et des milliers de spectateurs seront là pour saluer le départ de l'expédition Damas/Moscou. Quelles images merveilleuses à offrir au monde pour célébrer l'amitié entre nos deux pays.

Al Sham International Pure Syrian Arabian **Horses Auction**

(Old Damascus International Fair Ground)

Terms of the international auction:

- 1 The horse is presented by a special hostler chosen by the committee wearing a shirt bearing the number of the horse in the booklet.
- 2 Allow each breeder to use a special exhibitor wearing the exhibitor's shirt with the number of the horse.
- 3 Payment of 5,000 S.P. Only five thousand Syrian pounds as a participation fee in the auction.
- 4 Paying 100,000 S.P. Only one hundred thousand Syrian pounds for those who wish to participate in the purchase of horses from the auction and get a number (Racket) at the front row table.
- 5 The opening of the auction for each horse starts according to the total financial value recorded by the committee.
- 6 The males are offered at a value of not less than 25,000 S.P and the females with a value of not less than 50,000 S.P.
- 7 The auction shall be suspended when the paid amount reaches the secret price of the Commission, unless the auction continues escalating.
- 8 If the bid amount does not arrive at the price of the commission, the owner of the horse is asked if he wants to sell or not.
- 9 The amount of 100,000 S.P. is returned in case of non-purchase.
- 10 The auction process is repeated on horses that have not been sold after the end of the auction at the owners desire.

Cooking is an art with great connection to the human's civilization, till it became a form of sophistication and luxury. The Syrian Cuisine specializes in its diverse and delicious dishes known across the Middle Eastern cuisine.

The Syrian cuisine is an authentic and diverse cuisine that draws its diversity from the history of Syria, the country of civilizations and its capital, known as the oldest capital in the world, its Nature, regions and cities each has its own distinctive food between Damascus, Aleppo, Homs, Hama, the cities of the Syrian coast, the Syrian Peninsula, Deir Al-Zour, Al-Ragga, Badia, and the mountainous areas of Lattakia and Swaida and the Damascus rural areas. As for the Syrian main dishes, all would agree on the unique taste and variety of its recipes such as Syrian barbecue and the famous Aleppo kebabs and the famous Kebbeh, which are characterized by fried, grilled and raw and Kebbeh in a platter. And it's Syrian pastries and the Damascene Ice Cream and the royal Keshkeh and the Fateh Shamieh, Dawood Basha, Shishbarak, Shawarma and many more special dishes that are prepared to meet the taste of each home.

As for the Traditional Syrian dishes, they're many and varied, they're simple ingredients and easy to prepare, and are rich in nutrition to help build a strong body, Most of the popular foods are associated with the Syrian cities, which makes it easier for tourists to know the most popular food when visiting these cities.

Among the most famous Syrian sweets served in the holidays, such as Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha, we mention barazek shamiya, qatayef al-shamiya, halawa al-homsia, Balah al-Sham, Kanafah and Ma>mul. Traditional crafts:

Handicrafts are an old and popular part of culture that tell the story of civilization through the ages and are related to life and history.

The Damascene Sword:

The Damascene sword is considered to be a part of its heritage and the Damascene craftsmen are well known for their skill in making it. The Swords of Damascus called are called Damascene steel, and are considered to be the most important types of swords. The most renown swordsmen in Europe were not able to discover the secrets behind the Damascus Sword, the name of the metal from which the Damascus sword is made from made it to be considered a legendary metal. The sword has three main sections: the handle, the blade and the sheath. The blade is made of a group of different metals such as iron or steel, after the combination of the metals and the cooling of the metals, one can shape the sword in any way required.

Pottery:

The components of this craft were represented by the treasures of the land and in which they reflect the relationship between man and the land. The craftsman linked his artistic forms to real life, human needs and artistic creativity associated with the perspective and vision of contemporary building.

It is one of the oldest crafts that rely on simplicity, taste, pottery and the most important and oldest of crafts that have to do with daily life. They were found with both the rich and the poor in their buildings, their dwellings, household utensils and tables. Their historical importance comes from within the ancient texts. The alphabet of the world was written on a piece of pottery.

Glass Making:

Glass was known to be from nature and the glass was usually associated with pottery in the ancient times. Glass entered along with pottery in man's life and the respected industries flourished in Damascus. The glassmakers used the same methods in the method of invocation of glass materials and the method of manufacturing by using the pouring and dipping molds or the blowing methods through a metal pipe or by using pottery. Damascus was considered to be one of the most important locations in Syria for glass making dating back to the era of Zaher Baybars (1259-1277). It was also known to be popular for the manufacturing of mosque lamps and cups and cups painted with gold and decorated with many different colors.

Stained Glass:

Two types This craft was one of the most prominent of Islamic applied arts which decorated mosques and palaces: one method by Interlock by gypsum and the other with Interlock with metal (lead).

Mosaics:

Are a form of contemporary art, and are subject for their purpose and the location that they will be placed. To work with this craft, one needs to be creative, artistically innovative and the choice of the subject (nature - decorations in writing or engineering) and in the provision of materials in the form of stone cubes or glass charms. Its beauty comes from its small size and can be seen in many decorations in the Umayyad Mosque in Damascus.

Wood Crafting:

The abundance of wood helped the Syrian Artists and Crafters. The palaces and ancient houses were adorned with carvings, which were based on geometric and linear elements.

The types: inserting seashells and the Arabic-Ajami font

• inserting saffron and the Arabic thread:

Crafters excelled in highlighting shapes along with painting on wood and grafting material of animal bones or shells and using multicolored precious stones.

• Ajami:

It is a craft based on the decoration of engineering, plants and script. It is used in the covering of ceilings and walls in the halls or Damascene Houses or Oriental furniture.

• Mosaic:

A craft based on the geometric decoration of wood. It began with the use of a dry lemon tree. It was spotted by Damascene Jerji Bitar at the Franciscan Monastery in Bab Touma. The Mosaic style was discovered based on the artistic implications of art by decorations on wood from cultural heritage and art, skill, accuracy and unlimited patience.

It is made with walnut, lemon, rose, apricot and fig trees respectively and is used for furniture and jewelry boxes.

Fabric crafting:

The textile industry is one of the most important industries that depend on local production of sheep's wool which is widely available and the flax plant which is grown intensively in the plains of the eastern region and the northern and central regions, spinning and weaving workshops used them and showed extraordinary skill and mastery.

The hieroglyphic writings indicate that the Syrian craftsmen are masters of the textile industry dating back to the fourth millennium BC The writings and documents indicated that Syrian textiles have spread widely in throughout the world known since the start of ancient history. It is one of the most famous types of Syrian textiles.

Straw Crafting:

The roots of the plants are straw, and they are made from wheat, barley, reed scales, bamboo sticks and palm fronds. There are many plant fibers for this purpose. The making of straw is rural and was exclusively done by women, who many consider to be the source of human energies. The most important crafts are straw dishes, baskets, inventory, brooms, Various popular - napping chairs.

Leather Crafting:

Since the earliest of times, our Syrian society has been able to possess the art of human arts and creativity in securing their needs in its various forms. In terms of the relationship between organisms and their unlimited environment. Human activity in harmony with the environment has learned to develop knowledge and innovation in the manufacturing of tools and securing their needs. For the characteristics of animal skins and the methods of preparing and utilizing their use.

Musical instruments industry:

Since ancient times, Syrian Arabs have been known to use many musical instruments. They used the kasbah, the mazhar and the rabab. They advanced from singing and music to further stages during the Islamic times, especially during the Abbasid Dynasty period. They developed a number of musical instruments such as the oud, cymbals and the harp.

Arabic calligraphy:

Arabic calligraphy is one of the most creative in the Arab civilization and is the most comprehensive in its natural, artistic, literary and scientific manifestations. Professional calligraphers set specific rules and standards for each of the innovative lines. They were able to connect lines and decorate them as well. Syrian contemporary artists discovered the importance of returning to their Arab heritage to look for contemporary elements and abstractions to help them provide a modern panel that reflects the humanistic and poetic visions, they also discovered the importance of Arabic calligraphy and its expressive, decorative and typographical capabilities.

Thus, many have used technical experiments using the font widely in modern painting.

Copper crafting industry:

Copper ores are either natural, sulfuric or oxides. This heritage craft was known in Aleppo since the start of the century during the discovery of metal and its industry during the Islamic era. It was extremely popular in Hama, Homs and Damascus. And excelled in the manufacturing of pots, candlesticks, cuneiforms, musical instruments and artworks they are imported with the utmost satisfaction and approval



Syrian Arabian Horse – Origin and History

In the beginning, I would like to present all the love, appreciation, and gratitude to all attendees and absentees of this organizing committee and to the Mr. Minister for welcoming us. This committee is considered to be a great opportunity to gather the services, information, practical, technical, and administrative experience to maintain the contribution to the Arabian horse activities development and proceeding with supporting it materially and immaterially for the preservation of the Arabian horse which is our goal as a whole.

Documentary Information on the Arabian Horse in Syria

The Ministry of Agriculture and Agricultural Reform interest in the Arabian horse goes back to the fifties of the last century. The ministry had fertilisation centres of original Arabian stallions distributed over the various Syrian governorates and cities from 1950 to 1960. The interest in the Arabian horses was highlighted by forming a specilaised office in the Arabian horse in Syria in the Year 1994 AD.







The Syrian Arabian Horses Association (SAHA) was established in Syria in the Year 2003 AD headed by Mr. BASSEL JADAAN that SAHA put action plans and strategies, and started supervising all the activities of the Arabian horse in Syria in cooperation with the Arabian Horses Office in the Ministry of Agriculture.

The golden era of the Arabian horse activity in Syria started since 2004 AD to 2010 AD.

Races were held monthly in the cities of Damascus, Latakia, and Hama. Beauty and duty shows were held, as well as auctions, and horses' exhibitions for the requirements of the knight and horse in all the Syrian governorates and cities.





SAHA adopted as well holding and sponsoring beauty shows since 2004 till 2010, that six annual shows were held under the rules and regulations of IHACO.







Headed by the Knight MANAL AL-ASSAD, the Syrian Equestrian Federation (SEF) put a work programme for the organisation of duty and endurance races that qualifying and international duty and endurance races were organised as well as one- and two-star races in Damascus Suburb and the heritage Desert of Palmyra.





It is worth mentioning here the huge success in the organisation of the World Arabian Horse Organisation (WAHO) in Syria in the Year 2007. The efforts of SAHA, headed by Mr. BASSEL JADAAN, the Association Honorary Chairman, and in cooperation with the Ministry of Agriculture, private, and public authorities succeeded in hosting this world conference that most members are still talking about.





All such activities and efforts were made for the development of the Arabian horse in Syria till 2011 AD were suspended due to this injustice war on the Syrian people.

The Arabian horse in Syria had during the last years of the wars a great governmental and public support and interest that exceeded imagination by SAHA.



Huge Works in 2018 AD

The Year 2018 AD was a distinguished year for the Syrian Arabian horse and its activity in Syria that the following was made:

- 1 The Arabian Horses Office members and committees regained control over the Arabian horse traffic in Syria in cooperation with breeders and owners in most of the hotspots and the registration of the Arabian horse births. During the Years of 2016/2017/2018 AD, three visits were made to the eastern district of Syria, Alhasakeh, and Algameshli, the spring and origin of the existence of the Arabian horse with the Syrian desert tribes including Shummar, Tai, Aljubour, Alwilda, Alogeidat, and the rest of the Arab tribes. 2200 horses were tattooed during the three years. This was a great work of the Horses Office members who attended even to hotspots.
- 2 The number of the horses that were tattooed during the Year 2018 was (1022) horse.
- 3 We use the azotic liquid, the traditional way, to maintain the horses and not to be lost or stolen.
- 4- We issued the succession books consecutively since 2014 AD that the consecution books Nos. (13 + 14 + 15 + 16 + 17 + 18) and currently No. (19) is being printed comprising 500 registered Arabian horse and covering until the births of 2013 AD. Within two years, all the horses that are being registered in Syria shall be covered consecutively each year. Three succession books were printed during the Year 2018 AD.
- 5 The number of the registered Arabian horses was (8668) under our supervision and traffic.
- 6 We issued an international passport of the Arabian horse, the number of which is (2718) passports until now.
- 7 -The partial international ban of horses export was removed under veterinarian medical procedures and filed surveys by the international committee and the regional representative Dr. GHAZI YAHYA, that the Equestrian Club was approved as a veterinarian medical quarantine for exporting and importing the horses through the Lebanese lands in cooperation with the competent committees.
- 8 (72) stolen horses were restored, most of which was during 2017/2018, (22) of them were for the ministry and the rest for breeders, that they were returned according to their ownership after identifying them from the liquid azotic tattoo that is still being used by us and which assisted us identify the horses and their owners after restoration.
- 9 The Fourth Arabian Horse Carnival was held for the fourth year consecutively within the Grand Cham March in the streets of Damascus, and a race of the registered Arabian horses in Cham Race Course.







- 10 A higher committee for races in Syria was formed, and an annual races agenda was set for the 2018 season before the start of the season. SAHA, in cooperation with the Arabian Horses Office, held (8) races for the various distances in the governorates of Damascus and Hama. The average number of participating horses in each race was 40 horses.
- 11 A suite for the Arabian horse was dedicated in Damascus International Exhibitions 2018 AD that was outstanding and comprised:
- Organisation of Arabian horses march from Damascus to the Fairs Land with contribution of (55) knights and owners who were welcomed by the M/s Ministers and VIPs.
- Mr. Prime Minister, a number of Ministers, VIPs, and businessmen were welcomed.
- Arabian horses were exhibited in the suite and were seen by most visitors. The number of daily visitors of the horses suite reached 8000 visitors.





- At the end of the Damascus International Exhibition, an international auction for the sale and purchase of registered Arabian horses (WAHO) was held only 12. The most significant achievement in 2018 was the return to holding beauty shows of the Syrian Arabian horse after suspension of seven years under the supervision of Mr. BASSEL JADAAN the SAHA Honorary Chairman, in cooperation with the SEF headed by Mrs. MANAL AL-ASSAD, Mr. Minister of Agriculture Eng. Ahmad Fateh Algaderi, and the Arabian Horse Office which gave the breeders a great enthusiasm and effective contribution. The number of the participating horses was (107) horses most of which were of Syrian origin at (67) horses; the second day the IHACO championship took place with the participation of (40) horses of non-Syrian Arab horses.
- Gifts in kind were distributed for top winners and a number of official personalities and officials were honored





The outcomes of the war were passed and Syria restored its true position on the plan of the Arabian horse activities and maintaining it .






It is the political and administrative capital of the Syrian Arab Republic, where the main head quarters of its executive, legislative and judicial authorities its first university, diplomatic expedition and authorized international organizations, establishing its international historical heritage in ruins, and ancient neighborhoods eligible for housing trade and tourism, saving its environment Ghouta and water resources full of green areas, parks.

It is integrated with its beautiful, safe and versatile system, rational density, free from irregularities, slums and poor neighborhoods. Integrated with its services, resources, in fracture, clean and advanced transportation with Damascus

Free of epidemics, communicable disease, non-artisanal activities. Stable and safe families live in it in health and aging, future of education, business, of its children.

To be the nucleus of an active local community and contributed to support and finance of development through with an elected local administration that keens on its conciliations with high readings and cooperates with other provinces to achieve the vision of balanced national development.

GENERAL OBJECTIVES OF DAMASCUS GOVERNORATE

1- Administrative and institutional development:

Raise the efficiency of local capacity

Achieve the concept of partnership between different sectors of the community

Facilitation of administrative procedures.

2- Economical development:

Stabilizing Damascus as a commercial, financial and tourism center> Developing a modern and clean transport system.

4- Balanced development and environment:

Establish and protect the historical and cultural heritage of ancient Damascus.

5- The government also play her role in implementing the national development program for Syria in the post-war period, and it's from five interrelated axes:

Focus on institutional building and re enforcing integrity

Development and modernization of infrastructure concept (i.e. Reconstructing in parochial concept)

Growth and development concept (balanced sustainable) Human development concept (social, educational and cultural formation)

National dialogue concept.

The selection of the actions taking by the government and its arraignment is according to the following sequins:

> Immediate actions, which are aimed to handle emergencies that can't be post bond.

Short-term actions, which aims to handle situations that can be post bond.

Long-term actions, which are linked to achieving long-term vision and goals

DAMASCUS CITY IN 2020

Damascus governorate is following up the completion of the detailed organizational studies (areas of informal housing, and areas that affected by the unfair war,...etc) and the start of reconstruction.



The new regulatory studies include (public transportation, enough green spaces, parks, sports fields, recreational places, parkings, dispensaries, schools and other public facilities).

Pursuit the implementation of regulatory area 101(Marotta city), updated by legislative Decree No. 66 of 2012. Starting the implementation of regulatory area 102(Basilia city), updated by legislative Decree No. 66 of 2012. Areas being studied (Industrial Qabounl, Jubar, Barzeh, Residental Qaboun, and AL-Yarmouk camp) as well as the irregularities (Aisha River, Zahira, Tadamon, daf-ALshook Mazzeh 86, AL-Tabaleh, irregularities of Dumar (AL-RIZ Mountain) Acquisition of Qasuin and Mu'admia)

SECURING THE NECESSARY FUNDING FOR MANY PROJECTS

Damascus governorate is working on conducting studies on necessary funding for many projects and works sub-networks of sanitation areas. The stability of slopes in the northern and western cities, in addition channel to prevent floods and repairing of public parks and coordination of plants and removal of waste barriers and repair sites and address the problem of seasonal licenses. Finally restoration of important ruins in the city and reduce the negative impact on the environment from different means of transport used by citizens to follow up their transactions.

CITIZEN SERVICE CENTERS

Damascus governorate is following up on the simplification of administrative procedures and the creation of citizen service centers. The first citizen service center was opened 2010 in Damascus governorate.

Currently there are 13 centers in the districts of Damascus. These centers provide services in the Damascus governorate such as administrative licensing, leases, urban planning and organization, complaints, all the services of the old city of Damascus, the temporary registry data and the services of several other government which the citizen usually needs them in many of his transactions.

The most important of these services are the data of the directorate of civil affairs, the register of justice, non employee, data of real estate interests, the ratification of documents from the foreign ministry, and data from the ministry of industry.... etc.

The expansion of the services of citizens

centers will have an important role in linking the state to the community, so the citizen will have a good service and the state will have indicators of the level of citizen satisfaction with its services. When a citizen receives his or her service in a transparent manner, he/she has the feeling that he/she is dealing with one local authority and not with a series of complex administrative procedures and with a large number of employees. The idea of citizen service centers depends on the existence of centers capable of communicating between the governorate directorates and other government departments through various means of communication (systems, computer networks, fax, telephone, and E-mail) to secure the documents required to complete transactions of citizens through these centers.
